

New York Statewide Campsite and Cabin Reservation Program

Reservations are processed for a fee with all major credit cards accepted up to 9 months in advance. Call 1-800-456-CAMP or make online reservations on the internet at www.reserveamerica.com. All campsites, cabins and cottages in the Thousand Islands Region are site specific except campsites at Mary Island and Cedar Island State Parks. Site specific reservations allow you to reserve a specific numbered site, if available. Some parks may have designated prime campsites with additional surcharge and pet free areas.

Empire Passport Your key to all-season enjoyment at New York state parks is the Empire Pass. The Pass provides unlimited day use vehicle entry to most facilities operated by the New York State Office of Parks, Recreation and Historic Preservation and the New York State Department of Environmental Conservation. Come enjoy the forests, the seashore, lakefronts and trails... every day if you like, and bring as many friends as your car holds!

ACCESS PASS The ACCESS PASS is available to New York residents with qualifying disabilities. The Pass provides free entry and use of state parks and recreation areas and their facilities, except those services and facilities that are operated by a concessionaire. Application forms are available from State Parks, Albany, NY 12238.

Golden Park Program SENIOR CITIZENS who are New York State residents and 62 years of age or older can have unlimited weekday and non-holiday access to all state parks and discounts on certain fees by showing their New York State driver's license or New York State non-driver identification.

Pets & Rabies

1. There is a strict limit of two (2) pets per campsite and cabin, where allowed.
2. All pets, where allowed, must be supervised and kept under constant control, either caged or on a leash not exceeding six feet in length.

With the outbreak of rabies in New York State, it is imperative that the following rules be followed:

3. All pets must have a veterinarian's certificate of inoculation as proof of currently effective rabies inoculation. There can be no exceptions to this rule.
4. Feeding wild animals prohibited.

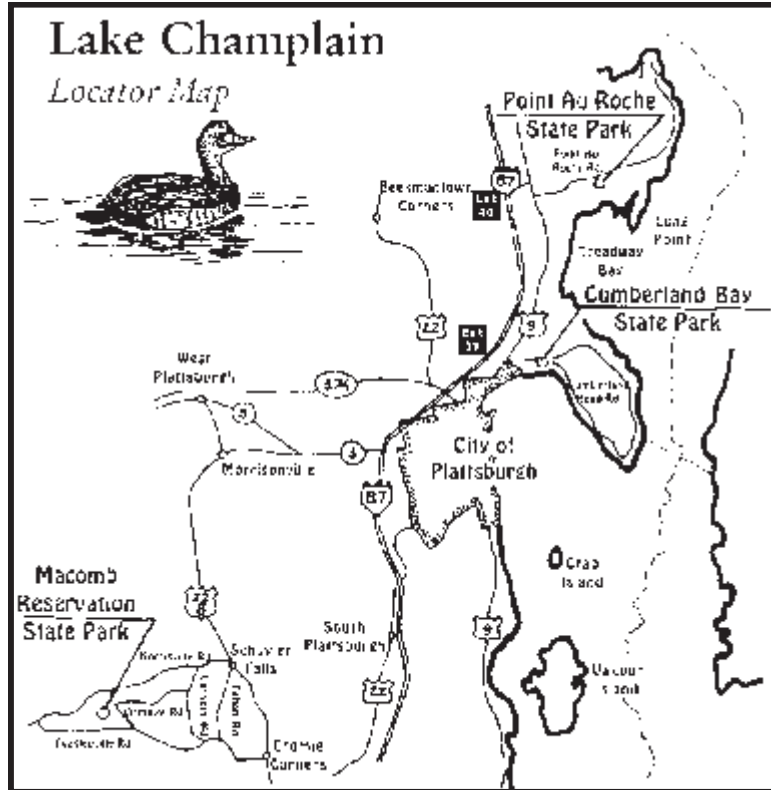

Park Recycling Program

RECYCLING IS MANDATORY

1. Clean and rinse recyclable bottles, jugs, jars and cans in your dishwater after the dishes have been washed. Mud sinks are also available for your use. Please do not wash out recyclables under water spigots or in restrooms.
2. Recyclable items will be checked and rejected if they are dirty or not processed properly.
3. It is the campers' responsibility to deposit garbage and clean recyclables at the centralized collection center near the park shop during specified hours.
4. A "carry in—carry out" policy is enforced for all picnicking and day use garbage.

The History of Cumberland Bay State Park

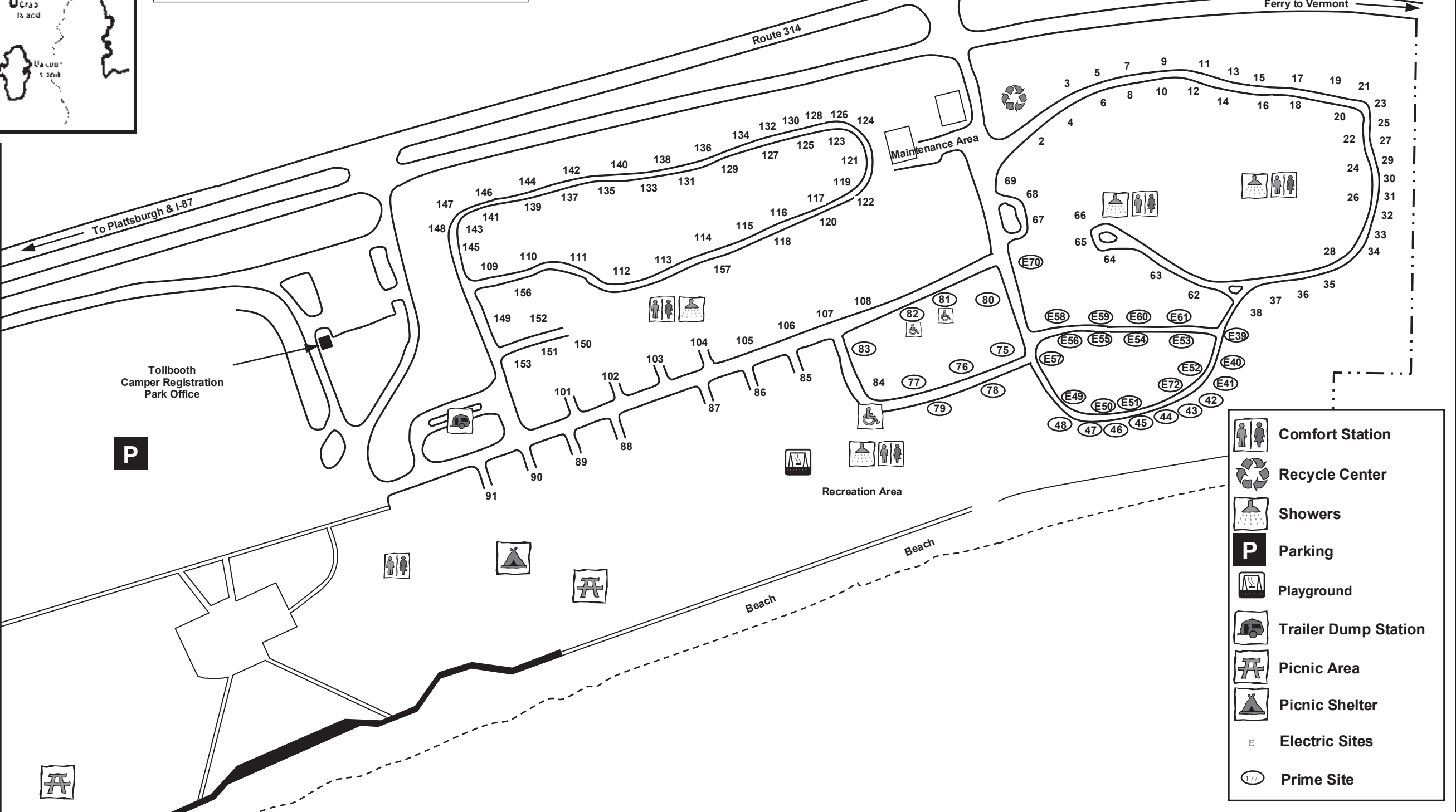
Cumberland Bay State Park is located on the northwest shore of Lake Champlain. Many of the buildings, beach improvements, etc. were built by the Civilian Conservation Corps (CCC) during the "New Deal" period of administration of President Franklin D. Roosevelt. The CCC Camp was located at Cumberland Bay State Park and housed young men from all over the country. The primary objective during that time was to intensively develop the marsh and sand dunes area—which constitute 2,700 feet of lakefront—into a modern, up-to-date State Campsite.

Cumberland Bay Today

Today Cumberland Bay State Park is a very popular camping and day use area adjacent to the city of Plattsburgh. The park offers over 152 campsites, a large picnic area and a beautiful 2,700 foot natural sand beach.

2. All pets must be secured by a 6 foot or shorter leash and under complete control at all times.
3. Pets are prohibited in the beach area.
4. All plants, trees and animals are protected by law.
