

New York Statewide Campsite and Cabin Reservation Program

Reservations are accepted up to 9 months prior to the first night of stay at https://newyorkstateparks.reserveamerica.com/ or by calling 1-800-456-CAMP.

All campsites, cabins and cottages in the Thousand Islands Region are site specific except campsites at Mary Island and Cedar Island State Parks. Some parks may have designated waterfront campsites with additional surcharge and pet free areas.



The Empire Pass is your key to all-season enjoyment at New York State Parks! A wallet-sized card that can be shared within

a household and not assigned to a specific vehicle. The card provides unlimited day-use vehicle entry to most facilities operated by New York State Parks and the State Department of Environmental Conservation including forests, beaches, trails and more.

Empire Passes are available for different lengths of time: choose from one-season, multi-season or lifetime.

KEEP YOUR PASS! Empire Pass cards are also renewable!

ACCESS PASS

The Access Pass permits residents of New York State with disabilities, as defined in the application, free or discounted use of state parks, his-

toric sites, and recreational facilities operated by the New York State Office of Parks, Recreation and Historic Preservation and the New York State Department of Environmental Conservation. The pass holder may have free or discounted use of facilities operated by these offices, for which there is normally a charge.

The Lifetime Liberty Pass benefits include free vehicle entry to state parks and DECoperated day-use areas, state boat launch sites, historic sites, arboretums and park preserves, free golf at 28 State Park golf

courses; free swimming pool entrance at 36 State Park pools, and discounted camping and cabin rentals.

To qualify for the pass, the veteran must be a resident of New York State and provide State Parks with written certification from the US Veterans Administration or the NYS Division of Veterans Affairs that the applicant is a war veteran with a 40% or greater service connected disability as certified by the US Veterans Administration.

Golden If you are a New York State resident 62 or older, on Monday - Friday (except holidays), you can obtain free vehicle access to most state parks, boat launch sites and arboretums and fee reduction to state historic sites and state-operated golf courses.

Simply present your currently valid New York State Driver License or New York State Non-Driver Identification Card at the park entrance. No application is required as your NY State Driver's License/Non-Driver ID Card serves as your pass.

Pets & Rabies

- 1. There is a strict limit of two (2) pets per campsite and cabin, where allowed.
- All pets, where allowed, must be supervised and kept under constant control, either caged or on a leash not exceeding six feet in length.

With the outbreak of rabies in New York State, it is imperative that the following rules be followed:

- 3. All pets must have a veterinarian's certificate of inoculation as proof of currently effective rabies inoculation. There can be no exceptions to this rule.
- 4. Feeding wild animals prohibited.

Long Point State Park

Long Point is situated on a long narrow peninsula of land facing Chaumont Bay on Lake Ontario. The park is in a remote area offering an uncongested, relaxing camping experience. Long Point is small and almost completely surrounded by water offering great views from all over the park. The constant Lake Ontario breezes keep Long Point cool and mosquito free.

The sites in the park are fairly open, grass covered with scattered trees throughout the park. A gazebo is available and can be reserved by calling Westcott Beach State Park at (315) 938-5083. The closest towns to Long Point are Chaumont or Cape Vincent and each is approximately 15 miles away.

Chaumont Bay is a protected harbor for boaters and Lake Ontario offers endless boating opportunities. Boaters should be cautious and consider the weather reports when boating on the lake.
